Isaiah 2:3 states, *"Many people shall come and say, 'Come and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths.' For out of Zion shall go forth the law and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem."*

Ever since 1994, people have never stopped coming to pray. From humble beginnings at the Prayer House in KL, we have seen such an increase in prayer and prayer centres in Malaysia and other nations. We are grateful to God and thank Datuk Tony and Datin Alicia Tiah who have generously made this house available to be a house of prayer where so many have been blessed, set free, healed and delivered.

We thank God for Pr Lee Shaw Ming for taking care of the weekly Monday meetings whenever I am away. I also thank God for all the intercessors who faithfully come to pray at different times, for Judy who has faithfully held the fort for the Friday overnight from the beginning, and Sis Hong who looks after the place. Ever since God healed Sis Neo of terminal colon/liver cancer more than 12 years ago in the Prayer House, she has not failed to come every Monday from Klang to pray. The same goes for Sis Keow who was healed from severe arthritis more than ten years ago.

The Prayer House, Johor Bahru

Glory Place Singapore

Feeling a real burden for Singapore, I have been there four times this year conducting daytime teaching and Jesus Heals miracle services at night, as well as taking home prayer meetings and Sunday services in various churches. Our co-ordinator, Nancy Nguyen, has been instrumental in organising all the events and we truly appreciate her.

Several prayer meetings are held in Singapore under the umbrella of Glory Place. ON A PERSONAL NOTE

This year, the Lord brought us to minister again in Johannesburg (South Africa). We also went on a prayer journey to Durban to pray on land given for God's use and for the adjoining 15 acres. The plan is to have a prayer centre, an orphanage, a school and healing home. Durban is a city with two million orphans, many of whom are affected by HIV. Praise the Lord, work on the project has already started. We really want to uphold the people involved.

Other prayer journeys were made to Fukuoka (Japan), as well as to Manchester and London (United Kingdom).

Our trip to Mongolia was awesome. Praise the Lord that Mongolia now has more than 400 churches. This number is much more than the number of believers in the whole country when I visited 15 years ago.

Our host church has 1,500 members and runs a Bible School as well. The daily early morning prayer was attended by around 200 people of all ages pouring out their hearts to God. In class, the Bible School students prayed so fervently that I was unable to close in prayer.

In Ulaan Baatar, we held our first midnight hour Jesus Heals miracle service (12am to 6am) and amazingly, the sanctuary (a former theatre) was packed! All glory to God for mighty miracles including the reviving of a man whom the doctors had written off. We were so very pleased that more than 26 souls were saved at such an early hour!

In Darkhan city, by God's grace, we climbed by torchlight a pitch black stairway all 16 floors to the top of the second tallest building in Mongolia to claim the whole building, city and nation for the Lord. We were told the lift only works at election time.

On return to Malaysia, we received news that one of six apartments on the 16th floor was up for sale. Within a short time, the Lord released the funds to secure three apartments. We are praying to acquire all six. The Lord is thus fulfilling the vision of the local pastor and paving the way for Glory Place Prayer Centre, Mongolia. All glory to God!

We want to thank God for sister Rebecca Faulkner and welcome her on the Jesus Heals team.
